: :	rather than for the production of foreign intelligence or to point out an unusual figure of speech or for some similar technical/linguistic purpose, would be inconsistent with the terms of Executive Order 12333. The Executive Order, the primary document that authorizes SIGINT personnel to engage in SIGINT activities, is specific about the purposes for which SIGINT activities may be carried out. The sharing of voice cuts and/or similar material compiled in the course of SIGINT collection with other SIGINT personnel, like all SIGINT activities, must be done with the aim of producing foreign intelligence, or for some other valid official purpose under Executive Order 12333.
